Request for Proposals: Only Kerber Eck, Brackel submitted a proposal for South Grand's audit.

Public Safety: Officer Appreciation and First Responders will be moved to October 2017 due to a conflicting appreciation event that was already scheduled the time will remain 11AM-8PM at St. Pius Church. Mr. Bailey is reviewing the letter to Chief Dotson on the request to be one police district. Ms. Witt will be attending a meeting at the Real Time Command Center on March 21st discussing a program for business owners to lease affordable cameras, software and etc.

Maintenance: Still waiting on the insurance to proceed to fix the fencing in front of Great Clips. Ms. Witt received new pricing to install LEDs on Lien Tran's building and repair Tree House Restaurant from Reinhold Electric. Ms. Witt is out to bid for pricing to seal and strip the parking lot. Lastly, BRICO is putting together a price to fix the three lights in the Ritz Par that are loose.
